This qualification is part of the Community Services Training Package and addresses work in client homes and other community settings under regular supervision within clearly defined organisational guidelines and service plans. Workers carry out activities to maintain personal care and/or other activities of living for people in their own homes or other community settings; activities related to an individualised plan; and report directly to a supervisor. They are not responsible for other workers.

450 hours theory plus 120 hours of work placement
