

CHC40108 Certificate IV in Aged Care

COURSE OBJECTIVES

People who pursue a career in aged care and have obtained a Certificate IV in Aged Care, practice in residential facilities within defined organizational guidelines and service plans. These people report to service managers and liaise with professionals and other service providers. You may also be required to supervise and/or coordinate a limited number of other workers.

DURATION

625 hours theory plus 120 hours of work placement

ENTRY REQUIREMENTS/RPL/CREDIT TRANSFER

Students must be recognised as competent in six (6) pre-requisite units from Certificate III Aged Care or equivalent.

Successful applicants must undergo a Victoria Police Check. RPL/Credit Transfer will be offered to students upon enrolment.
